Answer two questions with a passage

1. Write the First Article.

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

What does this mean?

I believe that God created me and all that exists, and that he gave me my body and soul, eyes, ears and all my members, my mind and all my abilities.

And I believe that God still preserves me by richly and daily providing clothing and shoes, food and drink, property and home, spouse and children, land, cattle, and all I own, and all I need to keep my body and life. God also preserves me by defending me against all danger, guarding and protecting me from all evil.

All this God does only because he is my good and merciful Father in heaven, and not because I have earned or deserved it.

For all this I ought to thank and praise, to serve and obey him.

This is most certainly true.

2. What does the Bible tell us about the evil angels?

Jude 6 And the angels who did not keep their positions of authority but abandoned their proper dwelling—these he has kept in darkness, bound with everlasting chains for judgment on the great Day.

2 Peter 2:4 For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but sent them to hell, putting them in chains of darkness to be held for judgment;

Matthew 25:41 "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.'

Some angels chose to disobey God and were condemned to eternal punishment in hell.

3. The devil is the chief of the evil angels. How did the devil ruin God's creation.

Genesis 3:1-6 (The devil succeeded in leading Adam and Eve to rebel against God.)

Satan tempted Eve to eat the forbidden fruit. Adam joined her. Sin entered the world and God's perfect creation was ruined.

4. What was the result on God's creation of the fall into sin?

Genesis 3:6-19 (Adam and Eve's sin brought death upon them, alienated them from God and brought many painful consequences into their lives.)

Romans 5:12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned—

Romans 8:22 We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.

- a. Adam and Eve were alienated from God (spiritually dead), and incapable of fixing it.
- b. Childbirth would be painful
- c. Relationships would be unequal and difficult
- d. Work would be frustrating
- e. Nature would be corrupted by sin
- f. They would die physically
- g. They deserved to die eternally.

5. Passage - What was the impact of the fall into sin on the image of God?

Genesis 8:21 Every inclination of the human heart is evil from childhood.

- a. The image of God was completely lost.

Ephesians 2:1 *As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins,*

Genesis 5:3 *When Adam had lived 130 years, he had a son in his own likeness, in his own image; and he named him Seth.*

b. All of Adam and Eve's descendants are born spiritually dead.

Romans 7:18 *For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out.*

Romans 8:7 *The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so.*

c. All of Adam and Eve's descendants are by nature sinners and hostile to God.

6. *Passage* - What is the devil's goal?

John 8:44 *You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.*

1 Peter 5:8 *Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.*

2 Timothy 2:25-26 ²⁵*Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth,* ²⁶*and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will.*

Revelation 12:12 *Therefore rejoice, you heavens and you who dwell in them! But woe to the earth and the sea, because the devil has gone down to you! He is filled with fury, because he knows that his time is short."*

The devil wants to separate us from God and kill us.

7. *Passage* - Why didn't God destroy Adam and Eve?

Lamentations 3:22 *Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail.*

God is loving, compassionate, and gracious.

8. *Passage* - What has our heavenly Father done to rescue us from the devil's evil plan?

1 John 3:8 *The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.*

Genesis 3:15 *And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."*

John 3:16 *For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.*

God sent his son to

- a. Destroy the devil's work
- b. Rescue us from sin and death
- c. Give us eternal life by faith

9. Eighth Grade - Write the Fourth Commandment.

Honor your father and mother, that it may go well with you
